

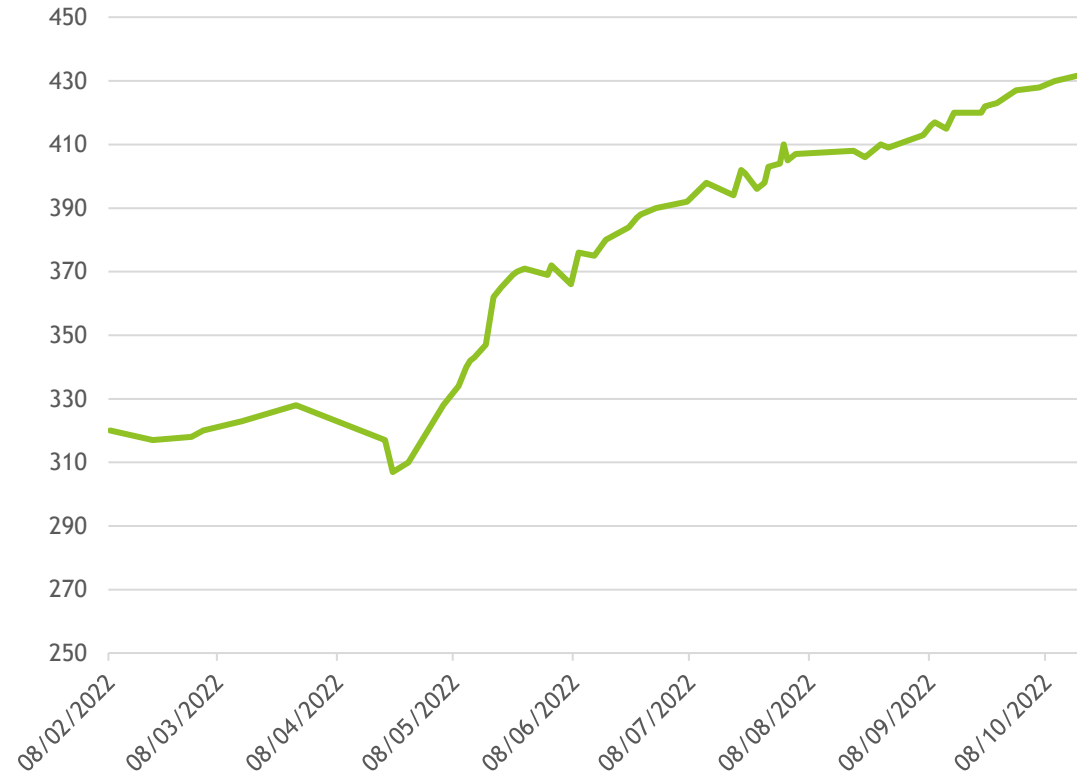

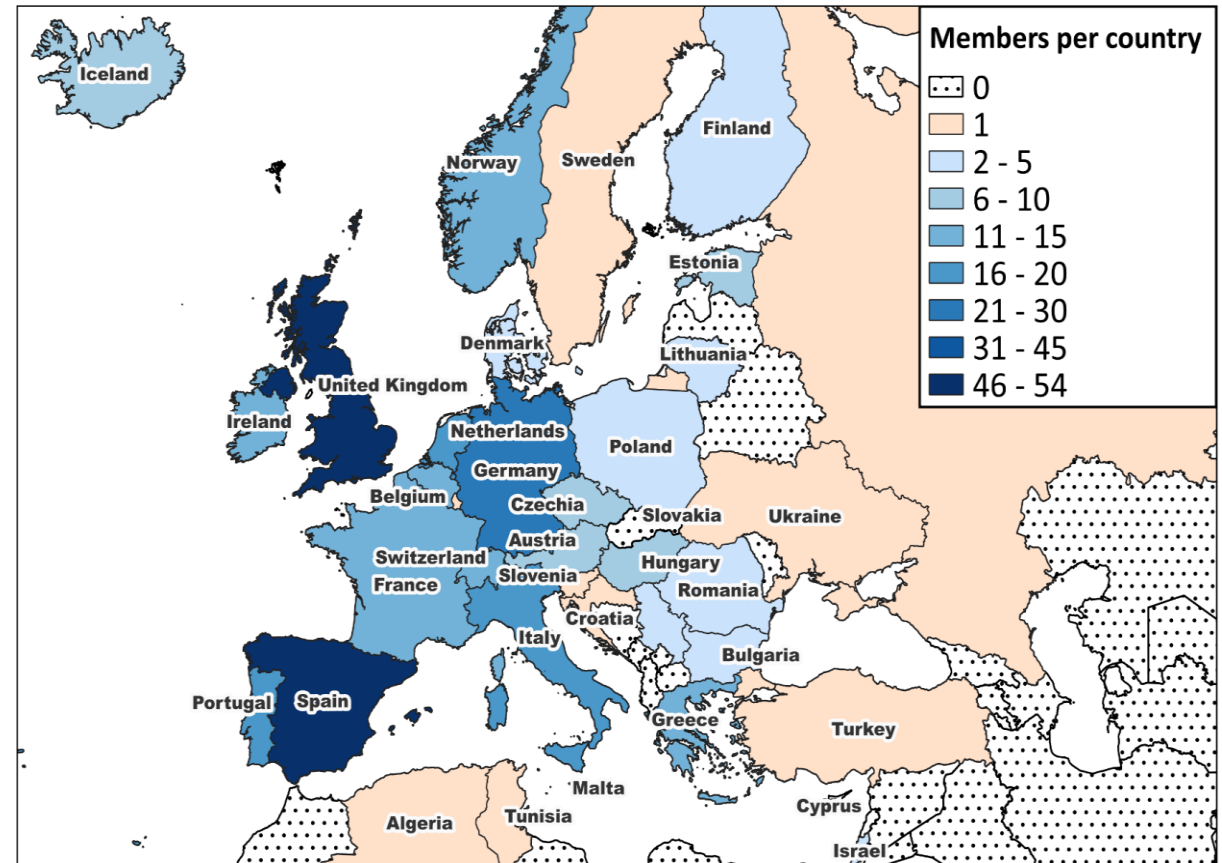


Where are we after the 2022 Membership campaign

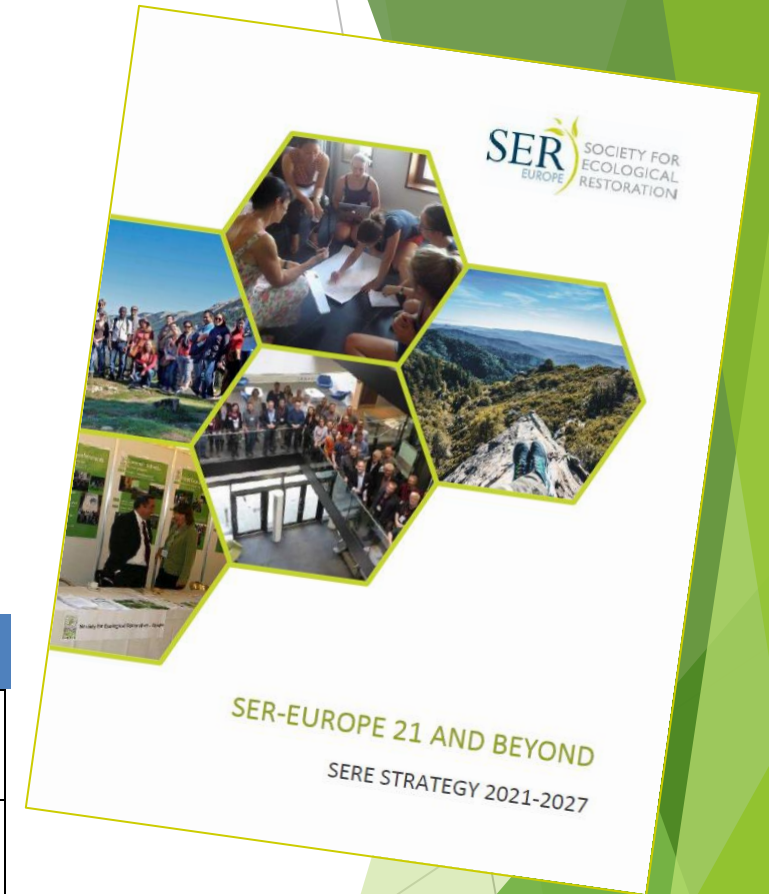

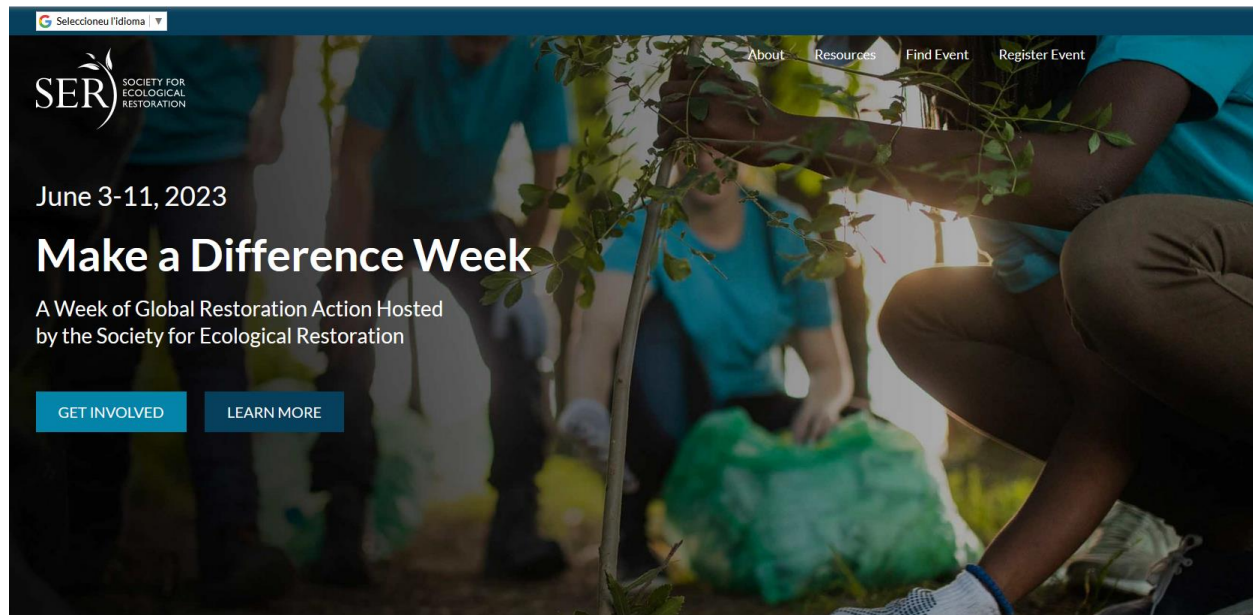

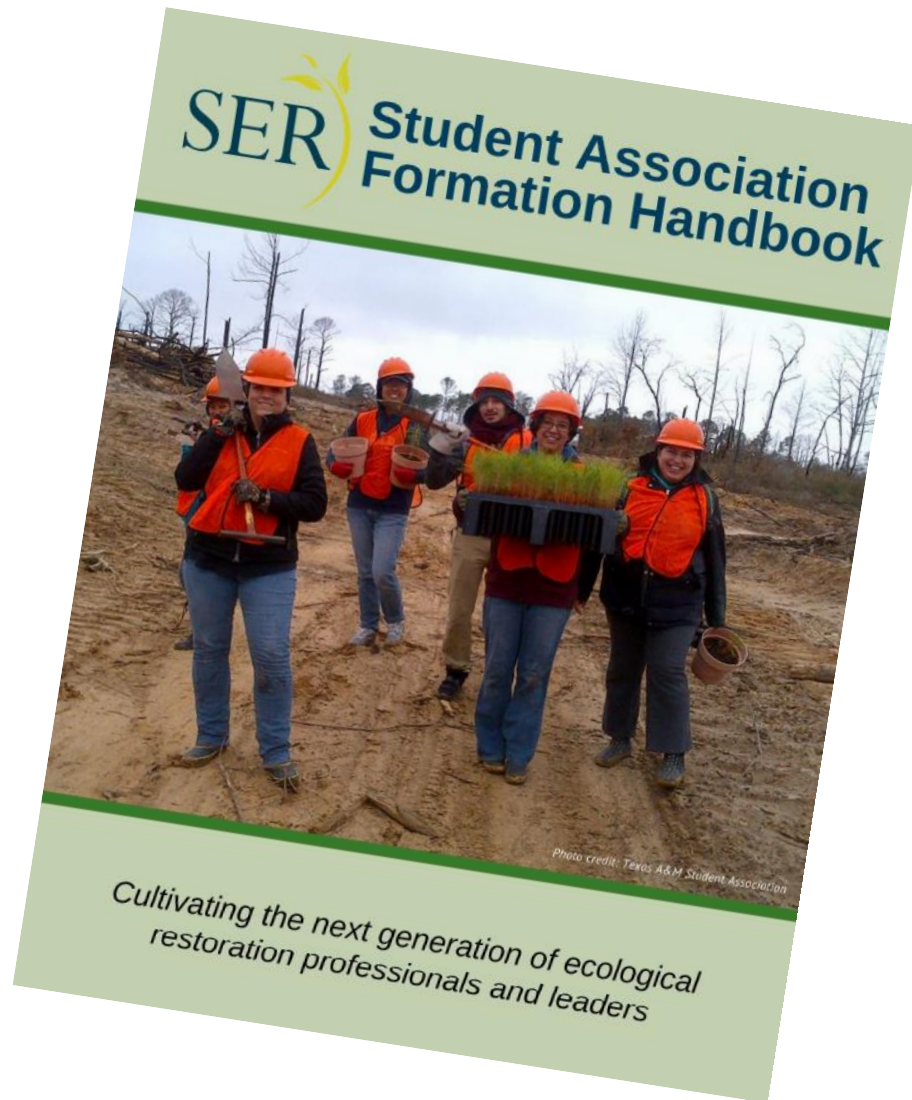

- ▶ 10. Engage in SERE activities and by others, be active!

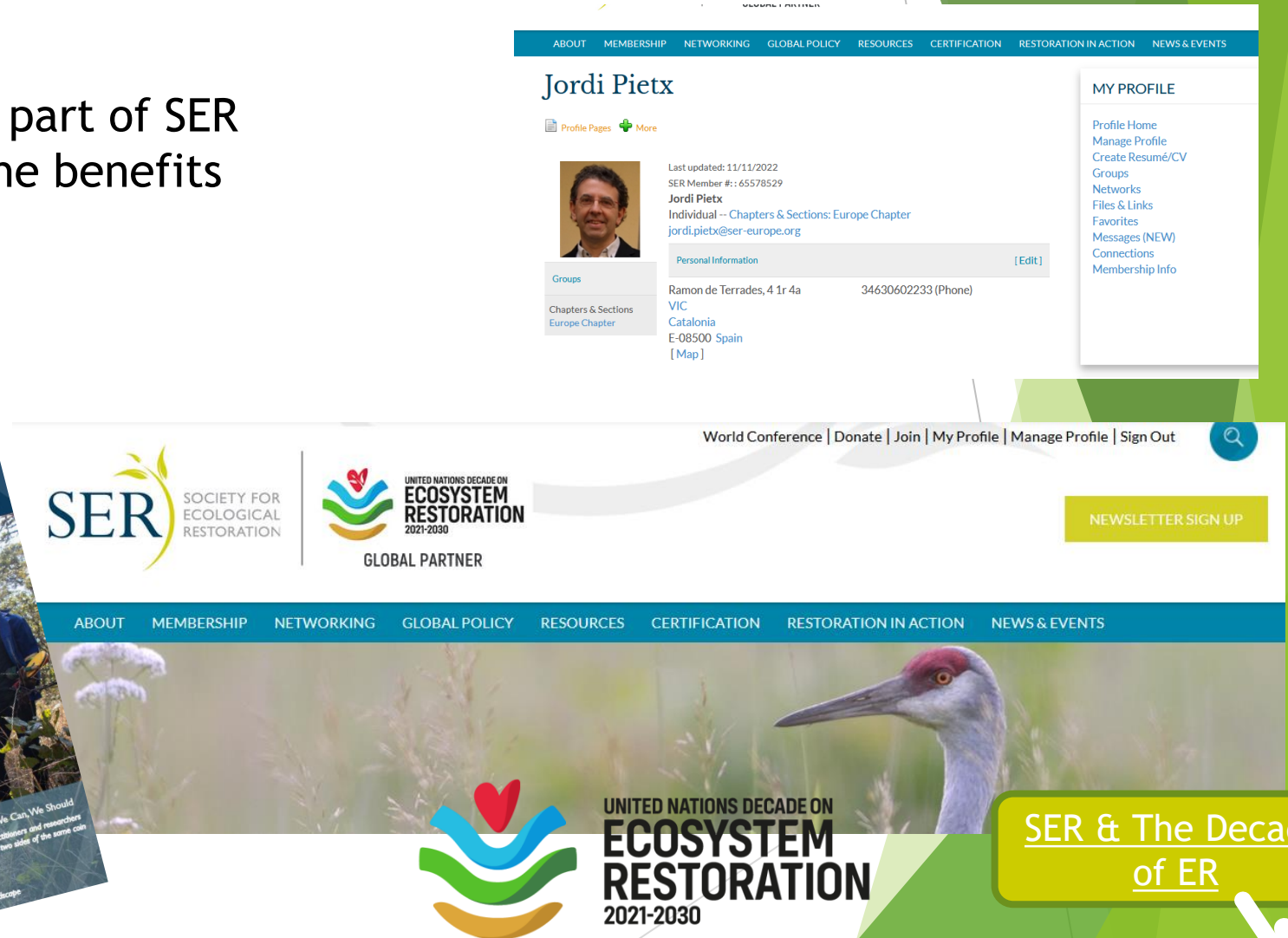

What is a Restoration Story?

SER periodically features active or recent restoration projects through an interview with one of the practitioners involved. These "Restoration Stories" allow us to give our readers a "behind the scenes" look at the work that went into each project. Stories are posted to our website and shared with our membership via SER's weekly newsletter.

The content of a Restoration Story is relatively flexible, but usually consists of responses to a set of general interview questions (provided below) and is between 500-1000 words. SER can also add images, videos (hosted on Vimeo or YouTube), maps, and/or organization/company logos into the Story.

How do I participate in a Restoration Story?

Step 1: Answer the interview questions below

Complete questions 1-6 to the best of your ability, and feel free to add any other information that you feel might be important to tell the story of this project. Your answers to these questions will form the bulk of the Restoration Story. **Aim for between 500-1000 words in total and try to write in a formal yet relaxed tone – the goal is to tell a story about your project, and not necessarily to convey technical information.**

The questions

1. What do you know about the history of the region or site? What was the ecosystem like before it was degraded?
2. What led you (or your organization) to work on this project?
3. Were there any challenges you encountered while starting the project?
4. Were there any major surprises throughout the project?
5. How does physically being at the restored site make you feel?
6. What are your hopes for this site in the long-term?

Step 2: Provide additional digital assets (e.g., images, videos, logos, etc.)

As mentioned previously, SER can add images, videos (hosted on Vimeo or YouTube), maps, and/or organization/company logos into the Restoration Story. Please provide these assets to our team, and if possible, follow the asset guidelines below:

- ▶ **Raster images** should be in JPG or PNG format – provide original/high-resolution version, if possible
- ▶ **Vector graphics** (e.g. logos) should be in EPS, SVG, or AI format
- ▶ **Videos** should be hosted externally on a video streaming service (e.g. Vimeo, YouTube)

Once Steps 1 and 2 have been completed, we will compile copy and digital assets into a Restoration Story post on the SER website.
